PRODUCT DESCRIPTION

Richard's Rich Classic Acrylic Ceiling Paint is a specifically formulated acrylic latex ceiling paint designed to renew old ceilings and wall surfaces. Its special "Spatter Free" formulation provides a unique flat finish that actually minimizes surface defects, resists soiling, provides excellent coverage, is non-yellowing and is easy to apply. It may be tinted to pastel shades of color, dries overnight to a plaster hard-like finish that provides excellent durability, and is easily applied to both new and previously painted surfaces. SURFACE PREPARATION		
GENERAL:	The entire surface area to be painted should be clean, dry, sound, and free from dirt, grease, oils, waxes, mildew, mill scale, form release agents, curing compounds, and any other surface contaminants that may adversely affect the performance of this coating material.	
PAINTED SURFACES:	Remove loose, scaling, cracked or peeling paint from previously painted surfaces in accordance with The Society for Protective Coatings specifications. Sand rough paint edges smooth to adjacent surface area. Sand glossy surfaces. Spot prime bare surface areas with recommended primer material and allow to thoroughly dry before applying finish coatings.	
NEW SURFACES:	DRYWALL: Insure that the surface is dust & chalk free, and primed with recommended primer. MASONRY & CONCRETE: Allow a minimum 30-45 days to properly dry/cure. The surface should be tested for pH and alkali levels and should not read higher than a 10.0 level. Clean surface thoroughly to remove contaminants, oil, grease and embedded chemicals. Smooth, slick, glazed, poured or pre-cast concrete should be acid etched, abrasive or shot blasted providing a finish similar to that of 60 grit sandpaper.	
MILDEW:	Surface areas affected by mildew should be treated with a commercial mildew removal and/or cleaner product following the manufacturer's application and safety directions. Rinse thoroughly with clean water, and allow a minimum of 24 hours to dry thoroughly.

RECOMMENDED PRIMER COATINGS

Although formulated to be self-priming on sound and properly prepared painted surfaces, the following Richard's primers are recommended for use on new or bare substrates:

• New Gypsum Drywall / Plaster:

- 7-11, HOLZTITE Latex Primer/Sealer Undercoater
- 7-22, HOLZTITE Universal Alkyd Primer/Sealer Undercoater
- 26, HOLZOUT 100% Acrylic Primer/Sealer Stain Killer

• New Acoustical Ceilings:

- 7-11, HOLZTITE Latex Primer/Sealer Undercoater
- 26, HOLZOUT 100% Acrylic Primer/Sealer Stain Killer

New Masonry

- 56. Signature Series Waterborne Epoxy Ester Bonding Liquid
- 1414, Rich Flex Alkali Resistant Acrylic Masonry Primer

APPLICATION EQUIPMENT

- Brush Application: Apply using a quality nylon, polyester, or combination nylon/polyester bristle brush.
- Roller Application: Apply using a ¾" 1¼" nap synthetic or lamb's wool roller cover, depending on the texture and surface porosity.
- Spray Application:

Pump: Gas or Electric Airless Sprayer

Pressure: Minimum 2000 PSI
Tip: 0.017 – 0.019 Reversible

• **Hose:** 1/4 inch (6.3 mm) - 3/8 inch (10 mm)

CLEAN UP & THINNING INSTRUCTIONS

Clean Up: Clean up any minor spills and spatters immediately with warm soapy water, as well as all painting tools and airless equipment. More serious spills should be contained and removed with inert absorbent material. Dispose of contaminated absorbent, container, and unused contents in accordance with local, state and federal regulations.

Thinning: Stir thoroughly and apply as it comes from the container. Thinning is not necessary. However, if thinning is required, you may add clean water up to ½ pint per gallon.

PRODUCT APPLICATION - General

Richard's Rich Classic Acrylic Ceiling Paint may be easily applied with a quality brush, roller, or spray equipment as follows;

- Stir thoroughly in a spiral up and down motion before and during application to keep product completely mixed.
- For best results, it is recommended to apply two finish coats.
- To assure color uniformity always intermix multiple containers of custom tinted and stock colors. Apply a small test sample to verify color.
- During application, always paint to a natural break in the surface, such as a corner or edge.
- Brush Applications: When applying by brush, use a quality nylon or
 polyester bristle brush, or a quality combination of both, and apply a
 smooth and generous coat on smaller surface areas, such as cutting-in
 larger surfaces and painting trim.
- Roller Application: When applying by roller cover, use a quality smooth, medium or rough nap roller, depending on surface porosity, and apply an even and generous coat in a "W" or crisscross motion, avoiding any excessive respreading or reworking.
- Spray Application: When applying by airless spray equipment, use a unit
 with a minimum of 2000 psi of pressure, with a 0.017 0.019 fluid spray
 tip.
- Rough or textured surfaces coated using spray equipment should be back-rolled to ensure a uniform film, even coverage and proper adhesion.
- Maintain a wet edge during application by brushing, rolling or spraying into previously applied coating area.
- Apply when surface and ambient temperatures are above 55° F and below 90° F.

PRODUCT LIMITATIONS

- Not for exterior use.
- Not for use in corrosive or chemical environments.
- Not for use in areas subject to intense heat.
- Not for use on below grade substrates.

PRECAUTIONARY & SAFETY INFORMATION

<u>CAUTIONS:</u> Avoid prolonged contact with skin, and breathing of dust, vapors and/or spray mists. Causes eye irritation. **USE WITH ADEQUATE VENTILATION!** Ensure fresh air entry during application and drying.
