## Color and Light

---

Light is probably the single most independent factor that influences color in a room. Paint, fabrics, wallpaper are all affected by light. That's why it is so important to "test" a color in a room before committing to that color.

Light colors reflect more light and thus make rooms appear larger. Light colors tend to open up a space. Light, pale colors work best in rooms with little or no natural lighting as they make the best use of reflected light especially during the day. If the room is to be used at night under artificial lighting conditions, colors of a medium value can also be used to great effect.

There are three types of lighting conditions in a room: direct and indirect sunlight, and artificial lighting.

- Direct and indirect sunlight are diffused through a room either through a window, door or skylight.
- Direct sunlight is consistent throughout the day and is thought to be the ideal light source.
- Indirect sunlight varies throughout the day and therefore affects the color in a room.
- Artificial light can be divided into warm and cool light.
  - Florescent lights have a cool bluish cast that tends to flatten colors. It is a bit harsher and sometimes causes hard surfaces to appear harder.
  - Incandescent or halogen light throws a yellow cast. It tends to highlight a room's colorations with a warmer more comfortable ambiance.
