COLOR BASICS —
Here are some helpful hints for using this Cool Color Card. Use the popular decorating principle of 60/30/10.

1. WALL COLOR:

Approach your walls as the foundation for your palette. A light or medium color will set the tone. This represents 60% of your space. Fine tune your selection with the help of our in store color selector.

2. TRIM COLOR:

Trim usually represents about 30% of the room's surface. Don't be afraid to use your imagination so that your home's interior will reflect your own personal style.

3. ACCENT COLOR:

A popular look today includes a third color to highlight or accentuate different architectural details of the home's interior, such as moldings, mantle pieces, and cabinet trim. The accent color represents about 10% of the room.
