






Exterior Colors

However, modern scientific paint research has gradually discovered a vivid palette and surprisingly flamboyant combinations.










Historic New England has won national attention for unlocking the secrets of how paint colors actually looked when new, before time, sunlight and weather altered them.



All colors are affected by age, light, heat and printing processes. Chips on card may vary in color or finish from the actual paint in the container. To achieve clarity and depth of color, some colors may require multiple coats. Colors shown are custom tints and may be slightly higher in price.


