PRODUCT DESCRIPTION

Richard's RichTex Level-Five Smooth Drywall Primer/Surfacer is a professional quality primer that is specially formulated to provide a smooth and uniform plaster-like hard "Level 5" finish to interior new and previously painted drywall, plaster and masonry surfaces. It provides excellent coverage and sealing properties, hides surface imperfections and joint flashing, and creates a smooth surface. Easy to apply, it is self-leveling, offers excellent sanding properties, and replaces the need for conventional primers, while providing a smooth finish for the application of both water-based and oil-based finish coatings

SURFACE PREPARATION

<u>GENERAL:</u> The entire surface area to be painted should be clean, dry, sound, and free from dirt, grease, oils, waxes, mildew, and any other surface contaminants that may adversely affect the performance of this coating material.

- PREVIOUSLY PAINTED SURFACES: Remove any loose, scaling, cracked or peeling paint from
 previously painted surfaces by hand scraping, sanding, wire brushing or by power tool cleaning
 methods, such as electric sanders or grinders, etc. Sand all rough paint edges smooth to
 adjacent surface area. Sand all glossy surfaces to dull existing finish. Spot prime all bare
 surface areas with same primer material and allow to thoroughly dry before applying finish
 coatings.
- <u>Surface Repairs:</u> Repair/replace any damaged and/or delaminated surface areas with the proper recommended patching and/or building materials. Allow patching materials to dry thoroughly before application of paint coatings.
- DRYWALL: Ensure that the surface is dust & chalk free and primed with recommended primer.
- Masonry / Concrete: All new masonry surfaces should be allowed 30 45 days to properly
 dry/cure in accordance with industry standards. The surface should be tested for pH and alkali
 levels. Surface should not read higher than 8.5 9 level.
- MILDEW: Surface areas affected by mildew should be treated with a commercial mildew removal and/or wash product carefully following manufacturer's application and safety directions. Rinse thoroughly with clean water and allow a minimum of 24 hours to dry thoroughly.

APPLICATION EQUIPMENT

Brush Application: Apply using a quality nylon, polyester, or combination nylon/polyester bristle brush.

Roller Application: Apply using a ½" - 1½" nap synthetic or lamb's wool roller cover, depending on the texture and surface porosity.

Spray Application:

Pump: Gas or Electric Airless Sprayer
 Pressure: Minimum 2700 – 3000 PSI
 Tip: 0.019 – 0.023 Reversible
 Hose: ¼ inch (6.3 mm) - ¾ inch (10 mm)

PRODUCT LIMITATIONS

- · Not for exterior use!
- · Not for use in corrosive or chemical environments.
- · Not for use in areas subject to intense heat.
- · Not for use on below grade substrates.

CLEAN UP & THINNING INSTRUCTIONS

Clean Up: Clean up any minor spills and spatters immediately with warm soapy water, as well as all painting tools and airless equipment. More serious spills should be contained and removed with inert absorbent material. Dispose of contaminated absorbent, container, and unused contents in accordance with local, state, and federal regulations.

Thinning: Stir thoroughly and apply as it comes from the container. Thinning is not necessary.

PRODUCT APPLICATION - General

Richard's RichTex Level-Five Smooth Drywall Primer/Surfacer is specifically formulated for application by airless spray equipment as follows;

- For best results, it is recommended to use a unit with a minimum of 2700 -3000 psi of pressure, and an output of at least 1 gallon per minute, with a 0.019 – 0.023 spray tip.
- For tight areas, you may want to lower the pressure on your pump and use a smaller tip, such as 519 spray tip. Use a 30-mesh filter for your airless and REMOVE THE GUN FILTER.
- Material line should be % inch in diameter for the first 50 feet of hose, then
 you can reduce to ¼ inch.
- There are two methods to apply product to achieve a level 5 finish. The first method is to apply product at 20 mils wet and allow to dry.
- · Touch up any areas if needed and allow them to dry thoroughly.
- Sand the surface of the touch up areas with 220 grit sandpaper or sanding screen. Apply a second coat at 20 mils and allow to dry.
- The second method is to apply material at 30 mils all at once. This method requires close attention to avoid cratering from material hitting wet material. Cratering can start to occur at 40 mils.
- Spray application is not recommended to exceed 30 mils in one application.
 When sprayed at 30 mils, product will dry to approximately 11mils.
- Material should be applied to walls first to eliminate fallout on sanding fuzz.
- During spray application, the surface area may be back-rolled to ensure proper adhesion, an even coat application and to effectively work primer into surface pores, however, back-rolling will leave a stipple effect.
- Once the material is completely dry you may sand the surface with 220 grit sandpaper or sanding screen to create a smooth plaster-like finish.
- Allow material to dry thoroughly before applying recommended finish coatings. Apply when surface and ambient temperatures are above 55°F.

PRECAUTIONARY & SAFETY INFORMATION

<u>CAUTIONS:</u> Avoid prolonged contact with skin, and breathing of dust, vapors and/or spray mists. Causes eye irritation. **USE WITH ADEQUATE VENTILATION!** Ensure fresh air entry during application and drying. If you experience eye water, headache, or dizziness, or if air monitoring demonstrates vapor/mist levels are above applicable limits, wear an appropriately fitted respirator, (NIOSH approved), during and after application.
